Pebble Beach Company Rules and Regulations

As of February, 2020

- 1. The pier is open to the public for recreational uses during daylight hours only. 2. Use of the pier is at your own risk. No lifeguard on duty.
- 3. No overnight camping, firearms or weapons, spearguns, collecting of protected marine species, or other activities that are unlawful or unsafe are permitted on the pier.
- 4. Sunbathing, beachcombing, picnicking, swimming, water entry for scuba diving and spearfishing, and water entry for small watercraft are allowed on the beach to the east of the pier. No overnight camping, firearms or weapons, motorized vehicles, collecting of protected marine species, or other activities that are unlawful or unsafe are permitted on the beach.
- 5. Boat Launching For non-commercial / recreational use by reservation only Boat hoist available annually May 15 Sept.15, only;
 - Use of boat hoist is restricted to authorized personnel only;
 - Boat owners must provide their own lifting straps for use of hoist;
 - Limit of 10 boats may be launched from the boat hoist per day; Inquire at (831) 625-8536 for boat launch and user fees.
- 6. Loading / unloading of equipment is limited to 15 minutes in the marked equipment drop off / pickup area.

7. Parking

- Reserved parking is located before the entry to the main Beach Club parking lot on the opposite side of the hedgerow separating the parking area from the 17th Hole of Pebble Beach Golf Links. For reservations inquire at (831) 625-8536.
- Unreserved parking is available nearby on a first come, first served basis in the Tennis Court parking lot and the Casa Palmero/Spa parking lot, both located off Palmero Way.
- Parking in the main Beach Club parking lot is for Beach Club members only.
- Except during permissible 15-minute loading/unloading periods, non-member vehicles left parked in the main Beach Club parking lot will be towed at the vehicle owner's expense.

8. Periods of Restricted Access

- Daily 11 AM 2 PM: The main Beach Club parking lot is closed to all non-member automobile traffic (no equipment drop-off or pick-up permitted during this period). Pedestrian access during this period, however, remains permissible.
- Special Events: The pier facilities will be closed during periods when entry to the Del Monte Forest by the general public is restricted (e.g., during the Concours d'Elegance and major golf tournaments), or when major events are scheduled at The Beach Club (e.g. recreational / social events), provided, however, that the total number of closures may not exceed 45 days per year.

9.	From September 16 – May 14, the pier hoist and other pier facilities are closed. Pedestrian access during this period, however, remains permissible.
